Welcome back to the start of another Scouting year.

Programme

We have a full programme this autumn term and events planned through to next summer, see details below. This coming term, in preparation for adventurous activities, we hope to get the whole troop to the highest stage that each Scout can achieve in the Emergency Aid badge. The first major activity of the term will be the Autumn Camp on 10th 11th October when we will be hiking through the Northamptonshire countryside and camping in shelters at Fineshades. A separate notice will be issued for this and is available on the troop website.

Apollo Troop Membership

We are very pleased that the success of the troop has been reflected in the number of Scouts staying with us from Cubs through to Explorers and the many new members who have recently joined. We are starting this Scouting term with 39 Scouts but will soon lose 3 to Explorers as they reach 14 taking us down to a manageable 6 patrols of 6.

Having analysed the projected leavers over the next year and the lists of Cubs that are due to come up over the same period we have found that we could have a troop of 50 this coming winter which would be impractical and potentially dangerous for troop meetings. Even with a group of Scouts going up to Explorers in April the troop would remain in the 40s for the rest of the year.

Consequently we will not be in a position to accommodate new members who turn up to a troop meeting unannounced. The transfer of Cubs into the troop will be coordinated with the Cub Scout Leaders. Others wishing to join the troop are asked to supply us with: Full Name; Date of Birth; Address; Current Scouting / Guiding unit and position; Previous Scouting / Guiding units and positions, so that they can be invited when there is room.

Swine Flu

In order to minimise the risk of infection to Beavers, Cubs, Scouts, Explorers, Leaders, Helpers, and their families will those with Swine Flu symptoms, or those who have been in contact with someone who has Swine Flu, please keep away from Scouting events and meetings at the HQ.

Please do not attend any Scouting events or meetings until at least seven days after you, or those infected that you have been in contact with, have recovered.

Both have made a great contribution to the troop and will be greatly missed, although we hope to see them both again during their holiday breaks. We wish them both well in their continuing studies. Consequently our leadership team will soon be reduced in numbers. To address this issue we would like to start a rota of parent helpers to attend troop meetings to provide "an extra pair of eyes" and join in with the programme where they feel comfortable. We are a friendly team and have fun working together to put on the troop programme so if you have a few hours to spare on an occasional Monday night we would love to have you along. Patrols

In preparation for older Scouts moving up to Explorers we are in the process of reorganising patrols and appointing new PLs and APLs. When the new patrols are finalised Scouts are asked to make sure that the names and contact details of the other members of their patrol are in their record book.

Troop Meetings

Just as a reminder Scouts are asked to:

- Arrive for troop meeting in time to register and pay subscriptions before opening parade, inspection and flag break at 7:15pm.
- Notify their Patrol Leader if they will not be attending (Only Patrol Leaders should contact leaders directly).
- Be on parade (standing quietly at their place in “the horseshoe” at 7:15pm wearing full smart uniform (or dressed appropriately for a special activity when notified).
- Bring along a change of clothes for inside and outside activities (including coat and footwear). We will try to give notice of outside activities but sometimes we have to take advantage of favourable conditions at short notice. (There are still Scouts who come to troop meetings without a sweater and coat and are surprised if part of the meeting may be out of doors).
- Get changed after Flag Break, pack uniform away tidily into a bag and store it in the fixtures provided for each patrol.
- Leaders should be available to talk to parents and welcome new members from approximately 7:45pm once registration and opening ceremonies are out of the way and the main activities are under way.
- Get changed back into uniform for flag down and prayers at the end of the meeting.
- Take note of notices and pass on notices to the appropriate person at home.

Kitchen

Over the summer a new kitchen has been installed in HQ, including an electric hob and dishwasher. The kitchen door is locked and will be opened by leaders when necessary. This is out of bounds unless you have been specifically instructed to go in there.

IF you have a drink, or use items, it is your responsibility to wash up and put away.

PLEASE do not leave items for others to tidy up.

Will anyone requiring the use of Scouting equipment for their own expeditions, family holidays, parties etc please contact the quartermaster to make arrangements. We have a wide variety of tents, cooking & lighting equipment and are more than willing to loan equipment (subject to its availability). Donations are always appreciated.

Troop Subs

Subs are currently £3.00 per week. If you would prefer to pay termly or half-termly please speak to Glynis Titman, Troop Administrator. This payment includes not only contributions towards Scout activities and consumables, but also towards use of the building and a capitation fee to the Scout Association for each Scout which provides them with insurance cover, so it is important to keep subs payments up to date. Also please remember that even if your son / daughter is not able to attend a troop meeting they still need to pay their subs, so please remember to send double subs the following week.
